Her life is lived through social media, total perfection, but it all comes crashing down when an accident leaves her scarred, physically and emotionally. As she battles the past, and tries to maintain a relationship with her drug-addicted mother, Sonya, Casi struggles to get some balance back in her life. Then she meets Kyle Jensen. A man who has built a façade around himself, a man who lives a life some could only dream of while he keeps Jake, his brother, in line. As his relationship with Casi deepens, he starts to question everything about his own life.
