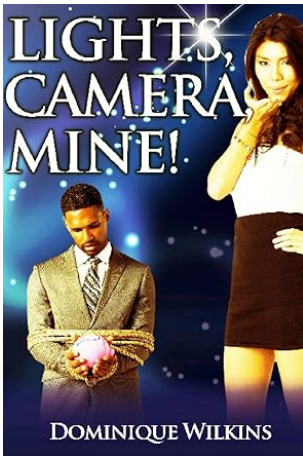

Dominique Wilkins' short story *Lights, Camera, Mine!* is a story of love, and the impact of being in an abusive relationship. Katrina gives her love to her family, her daughter, and the father of her daughter; however, that is not enough as Katrina is not receiving the type of love that she needs and deserves from Johnny. In the beginning of their relationship, Katrina loved the attention and gifts that Johnny constantly gave her. He was also older and more mature than other guys she knew. However, this attention turned into control and demands and aggressive behavior. As Katrina spends time with her friend Chris, she learns what true love is and how it manifests; however, it takes strength to take a stand and make changes and Katrina is not sure she has that strength.
