The book opens with a fictional story about a construction company owner called George. George inherited the company from his highly successful father but struggles to run it until he meets Marty. Marty introduces George to the five pillars of leadership, and slowly George learns to fix the company culture. In the second half, you will learn about the different ways to activate belief, mission, and vision statements, using marketing to develop culture, fostering a culture of authenticity, communication during training, showing personal accountability, and more.

Brian Gottlieb is a successful entrepreneur who founded a business that grew over time to attain annual sales of over \$150 million. In Beyond The Hammer, Gottlieb draws from his experiences and the knowledge he has acquired over the years to offer readers an all-in-one practical guide to leadership and management. Using storytelling and examples, the author takes you through the five pillars of leadership, delving into each of them in depth.
