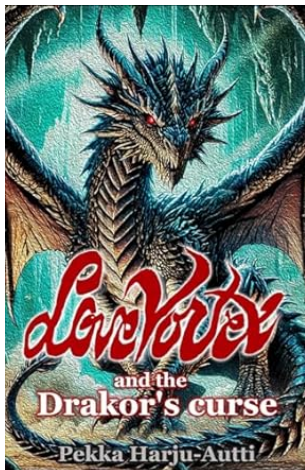

LoveVortex and the Drakor's Curse by Pekka Harju-Autti is a gripping historical adventure laced with eerie speculation and moral depth.
