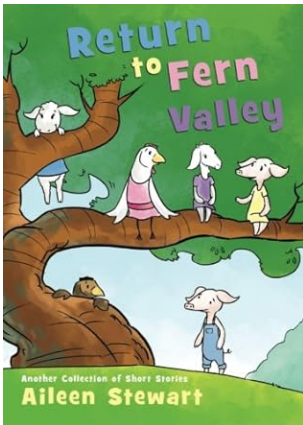

Our favorite barnyard characters are back in *Return to Fern Valley: Another Collection of Short Stories* by author Aileen Stewart. These 12 stories are entertaining and fun for middle-grade readers. You will meet chickens Roberta and Mildred Cornstalk, Jason Curlytail (a pig with five brothers and one sister), turkeys Alice and Henrietta Redfeather, and many more adorable animal characters. More interesting things happen such as people getting locked out of houses, a new baby is expected, clues are hidden in a book, and much, much more. Every chapter contains a subtle lesson for young ones. Each chapter is the appropriate length for a single reading session, either by the child alone or with a parent.

Return to Fern Valley: Another Collection of Short Stories by author Aileen Stewart is a wonderful collection of easy-to-read stories with colorful animal characters that are easily relatable to children. *Return to Fern Valley* is great for bedtime reading, library readings, or teachers reading to students a chapter per day.
