The Mysteries of Healing: Dialogues with Doctors and Scientists by Gayle Kimball, Ph.D. is an insightful and thought-provoking book that throws light on human consciousness, healing energy, and free will based on the research by 19 leading scientists. The book gives glimpses of other dimensions that exist beyond the Flatland, implying a dimension that exists beyond space and time which can enable psi phenomena like clairvoyance, precognition, and distant healing.
